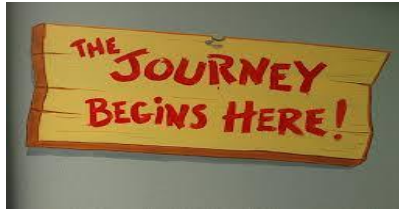

### **IMPORTANT REMINDER**

If your child arrives before 8:00 am., please remember to walk them into the building & sign them into daycare in Room 1. This is for your child’s safety. Please note: All children who arrive **before** 8:00 am and are placed in daycare will be charged a daycare fee.

Please follow the instruction emailed on the new guidelines for drop off and pick up of children at Discovery School. If you did not receive the letter with the new instructions, you can get a copy of the letter at the front desk.

Please keep your child at home if he/she has a fever, or has had a fever within 24 hours; has a heavy nasal discharge or constant cough; is extremely tired or fussy, indicating the possible onset of illness; has impetigo, has head lice or live nits; or ringworm as per The Discovery School Parent Handbook, page 22. We want our children coming to school feeling good and ready to work.
